NOTICE OF RACE

The Sanguinetti Dinghy Regatta will be hosted by California Yacht Club (CYC) on Sunday, May 2, 2010. CYC is located at 4469 Admiralty Way, Marina del Rey, CA 90292, phone 310.823.4567. Information about CYC and this regatta is available at www.calyachtclub.com.

1. RULES

- 1.1 This regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in the *2009-2012 Racing Rules of Sailing* (RRS).
- 1.2 The U.S. Sabot Highpoint Series Standing Rules will apply.
- 1.3 The Organizing Authority (OA) is CYC.
- 1.4 RRS 40 is changed to apply at all times while on the water, except when temporarily adding or removing clothing between races, regardless of whether code flag "Y" is displayed.
- 1.5 RRS 82 will not apply.
- 1.6 US SAILING Prescriptions to RRS 60, 63.2 and 63.4 will not apply.
- 1.7 The Sound-Signal Starting System of RRS Appendix S will be used with the following modification: the Starting Signal for each class will be the Warning Signal for the next class.

2. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 2.1 This series is open to U.S. Sabot boats.
- 2.2 Each entrant must (1) be a junior member of a yacht club or sailing association that is a member of US SAILING (or their own National Authority) and (2) meet the membership and measurement requirements of the U.S. Sabot Class Association (USSCA).
- 2.3 Each entrant must submit a completed [CYC Entry Form](#) and a [CYC Parental Consent Form](#), signed by a parent or guardian, to the Race Committee (RC) before the start of the Competitors' Meeting at 0945 hours on Sunday, May 2, 2010. Late entries will be accepted only with the prior approval of the Regatta Chairman.

3. CLASSES

Entries will be split into three (3) classes (A, B & C) based on the skipper's previous racing record in accordance with USSCA guidelines.

4. FEES

The entry fee is \$15 which includes bottled water, fruit and granola bars for the competitors while racing and refreshments at the awards presentation.

5. SCHEDULE

Six (6) races are scheduled. The RC, at its discretion, may run fewer races.

6. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

The Sailing Instructions will be available at the CYC front desk by 1200 hours on Saturday, May 1 and may be posted at www.calyachtclub.com.

7. VENUE

The racing area will be adjacent to the CYC Guest Dock in the main channel of Marina del Rey Harbor (F Basin).

8. THE COURSES

Courses will be primarily windward / leeward with some reaching legs if conditions warrant.

9. SCORING

9.1 The Low Point System of RRS Appendix A will apply, except that all scores will count.

9.2 One (1) race must be completed to constitute a regatta.

10. SUPPORT BOATS

10.1 During racing, coach boats will not be allowed in the racing area and must be tied to the dock. All individuals on such boats are required to wear PFD's when not at the dock.

10.2 Competitors who wish to bring support boats to CYC must make arrangements with the Dockmaster for use of the hoist and trailer storage. Contact CYC Dockmaster Ty Olsen at ty.olsen@calyachtclub.net or at 310.823.4567.

11. PRIZES

Prizes will be awarded at CYC as soon as practicable after racing.

12. DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

Competitors in this event are participating entirely at their own risk. See RRS 4, Decision to Race. By participating in this event, each competitor agrees to release the race organizers (organizing authority, host yacht club, race committee, protest committee, sponsors, and any others acting in an official capacity for this event) from any and all liability associated with such competitor's participation in this event to the fullest extent permitted by law.
